Author Guidelines

21st CENTURY analytical journal publishes analytic articles with primary focus on problems of the Republic of Armenia. The articles *ordered* by the editorial board of the 21st CENTURY journal are the property of the Noravank Foundation. The manuscripts are reviewed. Publications in the 21st CENTURY journal express only the views of the authors.

Manuscript Requirements

- 1. The articles have to be submitted in MS Word document format, using *Sylfaen* font, 11 point font size. The articles should not exceed 15 pages.
- 2. The author's CV and key words must be submitted together with the article.
- 3. The page size should be A4, with left, right, top and bottom margin sizes of 2 cm. The text must be in 1.5 line spacing. The articles should have an abstract (in the original language) and a resume (in languages other than that of the original).
- 4. Literature and references used in the article are quoted by a uniform and sequential numbering in square brackets, with page(s) referred to provided next to the number if a reference is used more than once. Pages shall be noted in the reference's original language, i.e. \(\foatign \) (in Armenian), c. (in Russian), and p. (in English, French or other languages): for example [1], [2, c. 11-12]. At the end of the articles, under the "References and Literature" section the literature should be listed in the same sequence appearing in the article, in the language of the original and 10 point font size. For example:
 - *Մարգարյան Ա.*, Երկրի մրցակցային ռազմավարությունը տնտեսական անվտանգության համատեքստում, «21-րդ դար», # 1, էջ 5, 2003։
 - Шарипова Р., Панисламизм сегодня: идеология и практика Лиги Исламского Мира, с. 15, М., 1986.
 - *Yasha Lange*, Media in the CIS, Center for Civil Society International, Amsterdam, 1997, from http://www.internews.ras.ru/books/media, Sept. 28, 1998.
- 5. References to Internet sources are preferably provided in footnotes.
- 6. In case of using sources other than in Armenian, Latin and Cyrillic scripts, the reference shall be provided in Latin script, with the translation and language included in parenthesis, for example: *Al-Arman fi Lubnan* (The Armenians in Lebanon, in Arabic).

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
